**GRATITUDE:** Thank you to all of you who offered prayers, cards, greetings and your presence at my 10th anniversary celebration this past Sunday. I thank God for the gift to be His priest and am grateful to be serving as your pastor.

Beginning in 2017, knowing that my 10th anniversary of priesthood was approaching, I began requesting from the Bishop the opportunity to go on **Sabbatical**. He has granted me that permission as long as I can find the priestly coverage for the parishes and the prison. Through prayer as well as phone calls and emails I am in the process of getting coverage of my responsibilities so as to get away for a 3 month Sabbatical.

**The dates I will be away are scheduled for August 26<sup>th</sup> to November 23rd, 2019.** I appreciate your prayers and assistance to prepare for my brother priests to come and guide you while I am gone. Please feel free to ask any questions or share concerns that I can address before my departure. My proposed schedule thus far is: a 30 day silent retreat in Assisi, Italy, a 30 day immersion in Spanish in Columbia, and a pilgrimage to Fatima, Portugal.

**Buttermilk Oven Pancakes -- An idea for Father's Day!**

1-1/2 c. all-purpose flour  
2 T. sugar  
1 t. baking soda  
1 t. baking powder  
1/4 t. salt  
1 egg, beaten  
1-1/2 c. buttermilk  
3 T. oil  
cinnamon-sugar to taste  
Garnish: butter, maple syrup

In a bowl, stir together flour, sugar, baking soda, baking powder and salt. In a separate bowl, combine egg, buttermilk and oil; add to dry ingredients. Stir just until mixed, but slightly lumpy. Spread batter evenly in a greased and floured 15"x10" jelly-roll pan. Sprinkle with cinnamon-sugar to taste. Bake at 350 degrees for 16 to 18 minutes, until top springs back when lightly touched and edges are lightly golden. Cut into squares and serve with butter and maple syrup. Makes 4 to 6 servings.
